

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 27, 2014

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At 2:00 p.m., the Commission and Adair County Assessor, Donnie Waybill, met with Brad Ray of Sprocket Technologies. Mr. Waybill wanted to express his concerns regarding service that would be provided by Sprocket Technologies. Mr. Ray was in the process of purchasing ETC Computerland, the company currently providing IT services to the County. Mr. Waybill asked if the service would be better in the future as he felt it had recently been inadequate. Mr. Ray stated that eventually he would have someone in the office to answer phones. His number one goal was to respond to service calls within one hour. Mr. Ray is scheduled to assume ETC Computerland on September 1, 2014.

Commissioner Pickens signed the Service Level Agreement between Sprocket Technologies and the Adair County Commissioners for Comprehensive IT Labor Services as well as the Service Level Agreement between Sprocket Technologies and the Adair County Law Enforcement Center for Comprehensive IT Labor Services. The current agreement with Adair County will continue through December 31, 2014. The agreement for the Law Enforcement Center will commence as of 09/01/2014 and continue until April 14, 2015 and shall renew for an additional twelve months unless written notice to end the contract is provided by either party.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on August 27, 2014.

The Adair County Courthouse will be closed on Monday, September 1, 2014 in observance of Labor Day. The Adair County Commission will reconvene at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, September 2, 2014.
