

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 26, 2017
12TH DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 26, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Commissioner Thompson will be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 9:00 a.m., the Adair County Commission met. Those present were 1st District Commissioner William King and 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson. They addressed a request to use the Courthouse lawn to hold a ceremony to kick off Mental Health Awareness Month on Monday, May 1st, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioner King made a motion to approve the request along with a contingency that if it was raining they could move it to the Annex building. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion.

At 11:30 a.m., the Commission addressed a request to use the Courthouse for the National Day of Prayer service on May 4th at noon. The request was for the use of the lawn and permission to move the service inside if there was inclement weather. Commissioner King made a motion to approve the request and Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion.


At 2:00 p.m., the Commission addressed a request by NEMO United to use the courthouse lawn on May 1st from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Commissioner Thompson made a motion to approve the request and Commissioner King seconded the motion.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 on April 26, 2017.
