

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 28, 2017
25TH DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 28, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. Presiding Commissioner Pickens and Commissioner King were present until 12:00 p.m. Commissioner Thompson will continue to be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission conducted a bid opening for fuel for the Sheriff's Department. Present along with the Commission was Dave Hurt, Finance Co-coordinator for the Sheriff's Department. Presiding Commissioner Pickens opened the only bid from MFA Oil that was submitted. The bid was read aloud to furnish Top Tier gasoline of 87 or 89 octane or E85 gasoline at 3 cents under pump price purchased at the pump.

Commissioner Thompson moved to accept MFA Oil's bid price. Commissioner King seconded the motion with Commissioner Pickens and everyone being in favor. Mr. Hurt will notify MFA Oil that they were the successful bidder.

The Commission discussed the possibility of closing the Courthouse on the afternoon of July 3, 2017 in conjunction with July 4 to observe Independence Day. Commissioner Thompson moved to close the Courthouse beginning at 12:00 p.m. on Monday July 3, 2017. Commissioner King abstained from the motion. Presiding Commissioner seconded the motion. Commissioner Thompson and Commissioner Pickens were in favor of the motion.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 12:00 p.m. on June 28, 2017.
