TUESDAY, MAY 2, 2017

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on May 2, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Commissioner Thompson will be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 3:00 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this meeting be continued in emergency closed session, with closed records and closed votes as permitted by law, for consideration of the following items as authorized by section 610.021.1 of the Missouri statutes:

Discussion under Subsection 1 of the statute for "Legal actions, causes of action or litigation involving a public governmental body and any confidential or privileged communications between a public governmental body or its representatives and its attorneys. However, any minutes, vote or settlement agreement relating to legal actions, causes of actions or litigation involving a public governmental body or" ... and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Those present were 1st District Commissioner William King; 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson; Attorney, Tom Loraine via telephone; and Deputy County Clerk Tammy Miller. So motioned by Commissioner King and seconded by Commissioner Thompson with all in favor at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 2, 2017.


Closed session ended at 3:50 p.m.
