

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2017
11TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 25, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. Presiding Commissioner Pickens was present until 12:00 p.m. Commissioner Thompson will continue to be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission met with Mike Deren of Group Benefit Services. Also present were Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, and Human Resources/Grant Writer Director, Heather Rohn.

Mr. Deren presented annual premium cost comparisons for Adair County's health insurance program. With current premium payments and claims being taken into consideration, Mr. Deren recommended that the County should retain their current premium structure.

Discussion was held. The benefit structure of the plan was also explained to Mrs. Rohn as she will be the one to facilitate new employees with enrollment paperwork. Commissioner Thompson moved to retain Group Benefit Services as the County's third party administrator during 2018 for health insurance claims. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner Thompson then moved to accept Mr. Deren's recommendation to fund the County's health insurance plan at the same level as 2017. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Pickens concurred. All voted in favor of the motion. Paperwork will be completed to bind coverage for 2018.

The Commission responded to a request from Brady Wilcutt with Faulk & Foster representing US Cellular. Mr. Wilcutt needed documentation that there are no zoning requirements with a cell tower unless in close proximity of the airport and there are no building permit requirements for cell towers within Adair County.

The Commission spent the remainder of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 25, 2017.




