

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2017
18TH DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on December 12, 2017 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. Commissioner Thompson will continue to be acting Presiding Commissioner during the absence of Presiding Commissioner Pickens.

At 11:00 a.m., the Adair County Commission and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, attended the annual budget presentation of the Second Judicial Circuit of Missouri as required by the Settlement Agreement of December, 2014.

The 2018 budget presentation was held at the Bruce Normile Juvenile Justice Center located in Kirksville, MO. Pat Williams, Court Services Administrator, hosted the event. Attending were the Adair County Commission, Adair County Clerk, the Knox County Commission, Knox County Clerk, two members of the Lewis County Commission, Lewis County Clerk, the Presiding Circuit Judge, a Juvenile Officer, and Director of the Residential Services for the center.

Mr. Williams provided a brief power point of the history of the facility followed by discussion of the 2018 Second Judicial Circuit of Missouri 2018 Budget. He reminded everyone that the County Commissions did not have control of their budget. It was presented as a requirement of the 2014 Settlement Agreement. After discussion, lunch was provided as well as a tour of the facility.

The Commission wrote a letter of support of the Northeast Missouri Community Action Agency, dba Community Action Partnership of Northeast Missouri's (CAPNEMO), application for the Missouri Housing Innovation Program (MoHIP).


The Commission spent the rest of the day reviewing budget proposals for the 2018 Adair County budget.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on December 12, 2017.
