

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, AUGUST 5, 2019
1ST DAY JULY ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on August 5, 2019 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission signed a letter of support with the Missouri Housing Development Commission in support of the Emergency Solutions Grant. The grant will provide funding to re-house those who are in homeless situations and/or avoid potential crisis due to eviction.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission met with Vince Fuemmeler of the IMS Technology Group. Mr. Fuemmeler wanted to explain his product to see if it would be something that would interest the County. He wanted to bid on the Request for Proposal of Technology Services (due August 19, 2019) only if they liked the concept of his company.

He has been in business since 2008 and helps entities go thru a digital transformation. He can provide unlimited licensing and has the capability to place all of the County's information in a digital file cabinet. The end game is the "Complete Cloud." Mr. Fuemmeler stated the County will never have to buy another computer or any hardware. It will be gone. All they need is a monitor, keyboard, and mouse which is supplied by IMS. He can provide unlimited servers and have up to seven layers of security that can be added as you need them. All backups would be taken care of and employee use sights can be restricted. Information can also be accessed remotely on a desktop, I-pad, or cell phone.

Mr. Fuemmeler stated that his service was priced per user per month. He is estimating that the cost would be \$150-\$180 per user per month. It is a process to get this idea integrated into the County. First a full assessment would be conducted and then steps taken to train everyone and place information in the cloud. It could take a period of months to get this accomplished.


Mr. Fuemmeler began presenting this idea approximately 6-7 months ago. He was approached by the owner of the Complete Cloud for help with taking his idea to smaller markets. This technique is currently being operated in larger, corporate environments. Mr. Fuemmeler said he would only be bidding on the information within the RFP and the digital file cabinet could be obtained for an additional cost. He mentioned that the Department of Corrections as well as the Missouri Department of Conservation used the digital cabinet concept. He has 4 IT people on his staff as well as others for his operation. The County would have 24/7 support out of St. Louis remotely, but onsite support would come from IT people located in Mexico, Missouri.

The Commission stated they were interested in this new concept. Mr. Fuemmeler thanked the Commission for their time and will be sending information for the IT proposal.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on August 5, 2019.

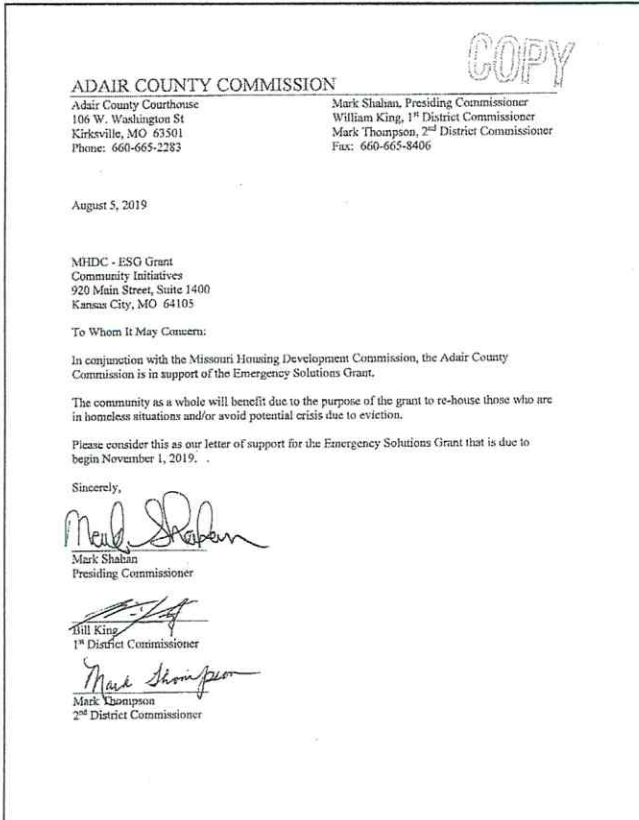
