

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2019
2ND DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on August 6, 2019 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:00 a.m., Commissioner Thompson moved to appoint Charles Cooper as the Law Enforcement Restitution Fund (LERF) representative for the Adair County Commission. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

The Commission along with Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, traveled to Livingston County to attend a presentation by Ivan L. Schrader of Schraeder Law Firm. The presentation was entitled "Medical Marijuana: Impacts on Counties & Public Entities."

At 12:05 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this meeting be continued in closed session, with closed records and closed votes as permitted by law, for consideration of the following items as authorized by section 610.021.1 of the Missouri statutes:

Discussion under Subsection 1 of the statute for "Legal actions, causes of action or litigation involving a public governmental body and any confidential or privileged communications between a public governmental body or its representatives and its attorneys. However, any minutes, vote or settlement agreement relating to legal actions, causes of actions or litigation involving a public governmental body or" ... and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner, Mark Shahan; Commissioner King; Commissioner Thompson; Adair County Legal Counsel, Ivan Schraeder of the Schraeder Law Firm; and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop. So motioned by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner King. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion at 12:05 p.m. on August 6, 2019.

Closed session ended at 1:15 p.m.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission attended the presentation that took place at the Chillicothe Fire Station on 2nd Street in Chillicothe, Missouri. It ended at 3:15 p.m. and then returned to Kirksville.
