

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 2020  
3RD DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on February 5, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Shahan and Commissioner King were present. Commissioner Thompson was attending a meeting in Jefferson City.

At 9:00 a.m., the Commission attended the Adair County Flood Study Review Meeting #2 at the Annex building in conjunction with the partnership with the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Present from FEMA/ SEMA were Darryl Rockfield, Jr., Floodplain Engineering and Mapping Civil Engineer and Cooperating Technical Partner (CTP) Project Manager, and Kalyn Bishop, CTP Project Manager. Also present was Josh Yarrow, Project Manager and Lead Engineer with Wood (Mapping Contractor).

Discussion was held regarding comments received during the flood study comment period, areas of mitigation interest plus conversation of community challenges since the last meeting. Draft maps were reviewed. It was noted that Adair County was last mapped in 1983 and this was the first County wide update in 40 years. Adair County does not participate in the national flood insurance program. The meeting ended at approximately 10:30 a.m.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Kirksville City Manager, Mari Macomber, and Kirksville Recreation director, Rodney Sadler. They wanted to discuss the possibility of purchasing land for an eventual trade with the school district for the Armory building located in Kirksville. The Commission stated they were not aware of any property for sale in the area but could possibly consider a sale of County land located by the Adair County Health Department.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on February 5, 2020.
