

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, MARCH 31, 2020
24TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 31, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:45 a.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this meeting be continued in closed session, with closed records and closed votes as permitted by law, for consideration of the following items as authorized by section 610.020.4 of the Missouri statutes:

Discussion under Subsection 4 of the statute "When it is necessary to hold a meeting on less than twenty-four hours' notice, or at a place that is not reasonably accessible to the public, or at a time that is not reasonably convenient to the public,....."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the door. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner Mark Shahan; Commissioner Mark Thompson; Commissioner Bill King; Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson; and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop. So motioned by Commissioner King and seconded by Commissioner Thompson. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion at 9:45 a.m. on Tuesday, March 31, 2020.


Closed session ended at 10:30 a.m.
