This benefit provides employees with the option to purchase a 90 -day supply of their generic maintenance prescription instead of the standard 30-day supply.

There are two distinct advantages to purchasing the larger supply:

- 1. Cheaper refills. Though the copay on the larger generic refill usually costs the same or just slightly more than a standard 30-day supply, the 90-supply is cheaper per dose overall.
- 2. Fewer trips. Purchasing the larger supply means spending less time traveling to and from the pharmacy and spend more time doing the things they enjoy.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM (LAGERS) THREE WAYS TO ESTIMATE YOUR LAGERS RETIREMENT

LAGERS' benefits are designed to be a reflection of your working career. The longer you work, the greater your benefits will be. The amount of your benefit will be determined using a simple formula. LAGERS uses the same formula to calculate retirement, disability, and survivor benefits.

1) Old School-Pen to Paper Calculation:

The formula used to calculate LAGERS benefits is below:

Benefit Multiplier x How Much You Make x How Long Your Work

Benefit Multiplier

(Adair County is 2% or .02)

X

How Much You Make

(average of your highest consecutive 60 months (5-years) of salary from your last 120 months (10-years) of LAGERS credited service)

X

How Long You Work

(vested in 5 yrs.-full retirement at age 60 for general employees and age 55 for law enforcement)

Monthly Lifetime Benefit


(after dividing by 12 months)

EXAMPLE: An employee works for Adair County for 15 years and their average salary was calculated as \$30,500. . . . 02 X \$30,500 X 15= \$9150/12 = \$762.50 monthly benefit (for single annuity)
