- 2. Calling Teladoc directly at 1-800-835-2362.

Teledoc is a simple new way to access qualified doctors and is a convenient and affordable option for quality healthcare.

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Teledoc doctors can treat many medical conditions (prescribe medication), including:

## Can Employees Make Insurance Changes After Open Enrollment?

#### The Answer Could Be...Yes

Employees are unable to change their insurance coverages for another year unless they qualify for a special enrollment period. A special enrollment period can apply for employees during **qualifying life events**. Examples of qualifying life events include:

- Lost of health coverage
  - \* Including job-based, individual, and student plans
  - \* Losing eligibility for Medicare, Medicaid, or CHIP
  - Turning 26 and losing coverage through a parent's plan
- Changes in household status
  - \* Getting married or divorced
  - \* Having a baby or adopting a child
  - \* Death in the family

Employees only have **30 days** following a qualify life event to submit a request for a special enrollment period. ## Reimbursable Deductible Allowance (RDA) Benefit

EMPLOYEES...ARE YOU GETTING YOUR CASH BACK?

#### This is an included benefit...all employees with GBS coverage can take advantage of this benefit!

Through RDA, a portion of out of pocket expenses applied to your deductible and co-payments made throughout the year can be reimbursed. *Employees and dependents covered under any of the Medical Insurance Plans can be reimbursed up to \$500 each year (Maximum \$1000 for a family)*.

To receive a reimbursement, employees simply submit payment receipts with the Explanation of Benefits (EOB) statements from the insurance company along with a completed RDA Claim Form. Human Resources can submit claims on behalf of employees or employees can submit claims directly to GBS either by mail, fax, or though employee's online GBS account.

Human Resources can help employees by...

- 1) Printing a list of all individual medical claims eligible for the RDA benefit
- 2) Providing RDA claim forms and EOB Statements
- 3) Submitting RDA claims

#### Flexible Spending Account (FSA) Information

You have until December 31, 2020 to spend any money left in your Flexible Spending Account (aka Flexible Benefit Account). FSA balance information can be found on your GBS online account or you can call GBS at (800)995-3569 for account information. FSA debit card swipes will be accepted until midnight on December 31, 2020 and paper FSA reimbursement forms will be accepted until March 31, 2021 for any 2020 expenditures.

2020 Flexible Spending Account money <u>cannot</u> be carried over into 2021.

While doing so he observed what he felt was odd behavior from one of the de-It was not immediately obvious tainees. what was going on, but instead of continuing on his way, he trusted his instincts and summoned help from his co-workers. It was then that they discovered the detainee was attempting suicide by suffocation. Officer Adams instincts, as well as Officer Tammy Key and Supervisor Broxton Powell's response, more likely than not saved a life. When this incident occurred Officer Adams was only on his 8<sup>th</sup> day of employment with the Adair County Sheriff's Office. All three were presented with lifesaving awards with their families in attendance on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. We're very proud of all of them!
