#### MEMBER PORTAL REGISTRATION GUIDE

The GBS Member Portal gives you the ability to review claims, request a new ID card, or send a secure message to GBS support online.

To access the Member Portal, you'll first need to register as a user:

- 1. Navigate to mygbshealth.com, then beneath the gold Submit button select Register Account.
- 2. Read the License Agreement, then select Accept.
- 3. Enter your Member ID or Social Security Number (SSN), last name, and date of birth in the fields provided, then select Next.
  - NOTE: If you are a dependent 18 years or older, select the checkbox next to Are you a dependent? and fill out the fields accordingly.
- 4. Enter your username, password, security questions, and security answers in the fields provided, then select Next.
- 5. Review the information displayed and if it is correct select Finish.
- 6. In the dialog box that appears, select either the Paperless or Paper Explanation of Benefits (EOB) option.
- 7. Select Continue to complete the registration process and enter the Member Portal.

Dependents must be 18 years or older to register for the portal. Though minor dependents cannot register for the portal, their claim information can be found in the primary policyholder's account. Primary policyholders will not have access to an adult dependent's account unless they are granted access by said dependent.

### ALLERGY SHOT MEDICAL INSURANCE BENEFIT

The County medical plan provides members with \$5 allergy injections\* from any in-network provider.

\*The \$5 co-pay applies to the injection only. Charges for doctor visits, testing, or other services may apply.

Receiving these shots works in three simple steps:

- 1. **Symptoms triggered.** When the member begins experiencing allergy symptoms (itchy/watery eyes, sneezing, running nose, etc.), they speak with their physician who determines what they're allergic to and what treatment option is best for them.
- 2. Injections ordered. Once the physician determines that injections are the best option for the member, the member will schedule an appointment to receive the injections. This appointment is typically recurs every week or every other week.
- 3. **Injections received.** The member will pay a \$5 co-pay for the allergy injection. An additional office visit co-pay or other charges may apply to the appointment.




#### Scooter Maniacs On The Square

FYI...if you move the scooter too far without paying through the smartphone app an alarm goes off! Dale found this out the hard way!




