Amount of Transfer: \$8,000.00 using escrowed funds from the 2014 Adair County budget



Order to Transfer Funds

October 15, 2014

Pursuant to the STATEMENT OF THE CASE, FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND DECISION dated October 8, 2014 (Case NO. 14-0074 and Case No. 14-0075) before the Judicial Finance Commission, the Adair County Commission requests a transfer of funds from Juvenile Justice Center Fund expense line "Transfer to JJC reserve" (907-5-003-902.400) to General Revenue Fund revenue line "Transfer from JJC Reserve" (101-4-000-700.701) in the amount of \$117,693.05. They also request a transfer of funds from Juvenile Justice Center fund expense line "transfer to GR" (907-5-003-902.401) to General Revenue Fund revenue line "Transfer from JJC" (101-4-000-700.702) in the amount of \$353,079.13.

Based on the record and memoranda of the parties and in light of the factors set out in section 50.640.2, the Judicial Finance Commission finds the 2014 circuit court budget requests to Adair and Lewis Counties to be unreasonable.





RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION OF THE AMEREN MARK TWAIN TRANSMISSION PROJECT THROUGH ADAIR COUNTY

WHEREAS, real estate values will substantially decrease, and


WHEREAS, economic livelihoods will be devastated, and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to protect Adair County citizens from this private company's (Ameren) efforts to exercise eminent domain.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this day, October 15, 2014, that the Adair County Commission does hereby go on record as absolutely opposing the establishment and construction of the Ameren Mark Twain Transmission Project.
