CONSOLIDATED TAX BILLING AND COLLECTION AGREEMENT

1. The COUNTY COMMISSION covenants and agrees:

a. (a) That it will maintain and permit the use of its computer terminal facilities and (a) That it will maintain and permit the use of its computer terminal facilities and soffice and staff facilities in the development, mailing, and collection of city tax assessments and notice to all applicable residents of the Cuty of Braskar, Missouring (b) That it will collect and forward to the CITY, on a monthly accounting basis, all taxes collected by the COLLECTOR on behalf of the CITY, together with the appropriate bookkeeping information and data which is reasonable and required by law, it the CITY for its tax records.

(c) That it will cooperate with the COLLECTOR and with the officials of the CITY for at the word the effectuation and execution of this Agreement.

(d) To be responsible for the computer programming, the assessment input into the computer, the tax billing printing, the mailing of tax bills, the collection of all assessed CITY taxes and as well as the sale of delinquent real property as set forth in Missouri Statute.

2. The CITY covenants and agrees:

(a) To compensate the Adair County Collector for the services proher at the rate of one and one half percent (1.5%) of the total amount of taxes to the COLLECTOR for the CITY, together with a penalty charge of search per that being the same amount as charged delinquent county tax payers.

(b) In addition to sub-paragraph (a) above, to compensate Adair Co. Missouri, by a further payment of one percent (1%) of all CITY taxes collecte COLLECTOR, in consideration of CITY use of County employees and equip collection of said CITY taxes.

Upon the termination of this agreement without further renewal, the COLLECTOR shall make available to the CITY any such existing records under her control is may be necessary to enable the CITY to undertake the collection of taxes assessed on city property in the CITY, in the year after termination.
