ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES TUESDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2014 11TH DAY OCTOBER REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 28, 2014 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Pickens and Commissioner Adams were present. Commissioner Thompson was absent.

At 10:30 a.m., the Elected Official's monthly meeting was held in the Commissioner's Suite of the Courthouse. Attending the meeting were Adair County Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens; Adair County 1st District Commissioner, Carson Adams; Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop; Adair County Recorder, Pat Shoush; and Adair County Assessor, Donnie Waybill. Absent were Adair County Collector, David Erwin; Adair County Public Administrator, Rhonda Noe; Adair County Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson, Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick; Adair County Treasurer, Lori Smith; Adair County 2nd District Commissioner, Mark Thompson; Adair County Circuit Clerk, Linda Decker; and Adair County Coroner, Brian Noe.

Mr. Waybill stated that beginning in mid-November, the public would have the capability to view their personal property on-line for 2015. In 2016, they will have the capability to file their personal property on-line 24/7.

Commissioner Pickens stated that the County storage unit at the Road and Bridge Department was nearly complete. Elected officials could begin moving their records from the storage units to the new building. Each official is to furnish all locks for their area.

Commissioner Adams reported that the new boiler for the Courthouse would be up and running on October 31.

Mrs. Shoush has plans of getting the information in the Recorder's office on-line in the future. In November, more filming of records will take place.

Mrs. Collop reminded everyone to vote in the November 4th election. Also, budget paperwork would soon be sent to all elected officials for preparation of the 2015 budget.

At 1:47 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:
