

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2015
1ST DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 2, 2015 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens, and 1st District Commissioner, Carson Adams, were present. Commissioner Thompson was absent.

At the request of Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, Commissioner Adams moved to transfer \$375,000 from the Law Enforcement Services account (301-5-001-400.000) to the Law Enforcement General account (801-4-000-700.200). This amount will cover salaries and other expenses through the end of 2015.

The Commission sent a letter to the 2nd Judicial Circuit stating a refund would be given for the auto insurance premiums for the two vans no longer be utilized by the Circuit. The check will be in the amount of \$173.50 and is reimbursement for the fourth quarter premiums on both vehicles. It will be issued with the November 15, 2015 accounts payable.

Darrell Draper requested that Lost Branch Way be bladed. He also stated that he intended to purchase one inch dirty rock to add to the road.

In the afternoon, the Commission toured County roads and bridges. They inspected the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) bridge on Underhill Lane, BRO (49) bridge on Foothill Road, and the property at 21678 Potter Road. Some removal of personal property had taken place at Potter Road.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 2, 2015.
