So motioned by Commissioner Adams and seconded by Commissioner Thompson with Commissioner Pickens approving at 10:05 p.m. on Wednesday, November 5, 2014.

Closed session ended at 10:57 a.m.

At 2:30 p.m., the Commission met with Mike Deren of Group Benefit Services. Mr. Deren said he was coming from the Adair County Employee Benefits Fair in which he had participated.
