

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2015**

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The Commission met with Sheriff Hardwick for clarification of board members to the Law Enforcement Restitution Fund (LERF). Sheriff Hardwick reported he had selected Burt Beard and Chris Taylor to sit on the board and Adair County Coroner, Brian Noe, had selected Raymond Schneider. Commissioner Pickens stated he had selected Dennis Sidwell and Carroll Hills as board members. Sheriff Hardwick stated that there were no term limits for board members at this time. The LERF board will establish their own rules and document their own minutes.

The Commission responded to an inquiry by the Adair County Health Department to be considered for addition to the County's healthcare plan. After discussion, Presiding Commissioner Pickens moved not to add any outside party/entity that was not under Adair County Commission's governing/budget authority to the County's health care plan. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 9, 2015.
