

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
MONDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2014  
12TH DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on December 1, 2014 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Alan Griffiths, Public Works Director, and Len Kollars, Assistant Public Works Director/City Engineer for the City of Kirksville. Also present was Isaiah Curtis, Adair County Road and Bridge Supervisor. Mr. Griffith stated that the City of Kirksville would soon be refurbishing Laurel Lane which is the road to Thousand Hills Trail - Forest Lake Pump Station. The City has been maintaining the road annually for approximately the past 10 years including grading and rocking. The City will continue to maintain the road, but the County will retain right of way.

Mr. Danner is the only property owner on the road and maintains that the road is his property. It was requested that Mr. Danner be notified to see if he had evidence for proof of ownership. The City and Mr. Danner will continue to maintain two locks for access to the road. The Commission will contact Mr. Danner. Renovations are to start in April 2015.

The Commission spent the rest of day attending to County business.


The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on December 1, 2014.
