However, any minutes, vote or settlement agreement relating to legal actions, causes of actions or litigation involving a public governmental body or" ... and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the doors of the Commission office. Present at the meeting were Presiding Commissioner Pickens; Commissioner Thompson; Adair County Deputy Clerk, Tammy Miller; Adair County Treasurer, Lori Smith; and via telephone Adair County Legal Counsel, Ivan Schraeder of the Lowenbaum Partnership, L.L.C. So motioned by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Pickens at 11:15 a.m. on Monday, December 29, 2014.

Closed session ended at 12:00 p.m.

The Commission met with Adair County Public Administrator, Rhonda Noe, for the 2015 budget hearing. Mrs. Noe requested additional money for traveling and training as her clients are located all over the State of Missouri.
