

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2014
23RD DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on September 24, 2014 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Second District Commissioner, Mark Thompson, called the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Public Hearing to order. Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens, seconded and the floor was turned over to LouAnn Rongey from USDA. Those present were Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens; 2nd District Commissioner, Mark Thompson; USDA, LouAnn Rongey; Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick; Finance Coordinator, Dave Hurt; and General Branch Director, John Axsom. No one from the public was in attendance.

Mrs. Rongey provided the Cash Flow Projection; Balance Sheet; Verification of Records; Association Project Information; Statement of Budget, Income and Equity; and Balance Sheet of the Adair County Road Maintenance Association. These were reviewed and signed by members of the association.

The Adair County Road Maintenance Association provided a letter requesting a USDA Rural Development Loan for the purchase of an upgraded security system for the county jail.

Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, told the Commission he believed it was in the best interest of the County to consider upgrading security at the Courthouse.

The USDA Public Hearing was concluded.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on September 24, 2014.
