Commissioner Adams wanted to thank Kathryn Jackson of the Humane Shelter publicly for her interest concerning the Commission and the Shelter. He stated the Commission would listen but make no decisions tomorrow.

Mr. Russell added that the mayor of Novinger was willing to give a little money for animals, but the Shelter would not accept any dogs from Novinger.

Adair County Assessor, Donnie Waybill, arrived at the meeting to discuss Midland GIS and the possibility of flying the County to obtain new imagery to update information for assessment purposes. The County was last flown in 2008. He stated the cost of the project would be \$154,000 and wanted the City to pay for one half of the cost.

Mr. Macomber stated that November 10 was the next date to discuss budget issues for the City. She encouraged Mr. Waybill to talk with the department manager, Alan Griffiths, or herself regarding this situation in the future.

It was noted that Sheriff Hardwick was working on radio communication with the City and may be utilizing a City tower for installation of equipment.

The pseudo-ephedrine situation in Adair County was also discussed. Banning the sale of this product over the counter in the County has caused offenders to go elsewhere to make their purchases. The product had to be sold at a pharmacy. It was felt that this action had made a tremendous effect within the County.

Mrs. Macomber ended the meeting stating that it had taken three weeks to do limb pickup from the last storm.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on September 29, 2014.
