Mrs. McIntosh said the building needed to be used for either records or storage. The County couldn't have it both ways. She again reminded everyone that anything inside the building should not brought inside the Courthouse under any circumstances including the air conditioners. It would only spread the mold spores and contaminate the Courthouse. Records should be kept in a temperature controlled environment being 70 degrees with only plus or minus 2 degrees and 55% humidity year round. The situation will get worse very quickly as the weather gets warmer. She suggested that the records be cleaned up, micro filmed and then thrown away.

The Commission stated they would try to address the problem.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on April 18, 2017.
