

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 2, 2014**

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At the written request of Matt Holt, Court Services Administrator, Commissioner Adams moved to transfer \$11,500 from the Juvenile Justice Center account (907-5-003-902.000) to the Juvenile Grant Operations account (909-4-000-700.100) so there are adequate funds to make payroll for the pay period ending March 28, 2104. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor. This transfer requested funds that have been placed in escrow in the 2014 Adair County budget until reviewed by the Judicial Finance Commission.

The Commission met again with Melody Whitaker of the Northeast Regional Planning Commission. The Commission submitted bridges for review of a possible Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project for funding in the future.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on April 2, 2014.

Amount of Transfer: \$11,500.00 using escrowed funds from the 2014 Adair County budget




