

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

MONDAY, APRIL 23, 2012 10TH DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30a.m. on April 23, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission conducted bid openings for carpet for various offices in the Courthouse. Present at the bid opening along with the Commission was Tina Cuculich of Carpet Plus Floor Mart. Bids were opened and read aloud by Presiding Commissioner, Stanley Pickens. Bids were received from Kirksville Carpet One, Joes Carpet Barn, as well as from Carpet Plus Floor Mart who submitted two bids. One bid was for carpeting that was in stock and the other was for carpeting that would need to be ordered.

Commissioner Thompson stated that based upon specifications they would have to go with the lowest bid. Ms. Cuculich thanked the Commission for the opportunity to bid. Commissioner Thompson then moved to accept the bid from Joe's Carpet Barn. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. The Commission will notify all bidders of the award.

The Commission submitted proposal requests to the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) for engineering services of BRO 48, bridge locations on Banner Lane, Benton Road, Oklahoma Trail, and Foxtrot Lane.
