Various concerns of multiple road issues were also discussed. It was ultimately agreed that the County would: #1) stop graveling Potter Road at this time, but would continue to maintain whatever rock that was there. The road would be re-evaluated in approximately one year; #2) in 2018, with Commission approval, \$831.00 would be put toward the cost of materials for Potter Road with no labor being provided by the County to fix potholes; #3) in 2017, \$1,425.00 would be put toward the cost of materials for Potter Trail with no labor being provided by the County to fix potholes.

The discussion ended at approximately 10:30 a.m.

At 1:30 a.m., the Commission along with Carson Adams and Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, met with Ivan Schraeder of Lowenbaum Law. Mr. Schraeder stopped in on his way back to St. Louis from a hearing in Schuyler County. He was to pick up signed affidavits by all parties involved in the lawsuit involving the Greentop Volunteer Fire Association. Mr. Schraeder also discussed practical approaches for the lawsuit in the near future.

Commissioner Thompson asked Mr. Schraeder for his possible assistance in Case 17AR-CV00013 Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System vs the City of Kirksville and Adair County. He had requested a change of judge for this case, but it had not yet been completed. Mr. Schraeder stated he could help, if needed, but suggested a letter be sent again requesting the change. Commissioner Thompson then left to get his affidavit notarized.

Mr. King told Mr. Schraeder they did not need his help. Mrs. Collop told Mr. King we may need his help in the future to get things completed. Mr. King said it was not her concern – just Mark's and his.

Commissioner Thompson signed a Subaward Agreement with the University of Central Missouri for the Youth Alcohol Enforcement Campaign beginning May 4, 2017 and ending May 16, 2017.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on April 3, 2017.
