

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 22, 2018
10TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on August 22, 2018 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The scheduled 9:00 a.m. six month budget review for the Road and Bridge Department was postponed due to Isaiah Curtis, Road and Bridge Supervisor, not being able to attend the meeting. The review will be re-scheduled in the near future.

Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, asked the Commission to review RSMo 190.455 (effective August 28, 2018) regarding terminology to fund 911. It was brought to her attention there was a land line tax which had been passed by the voters in 2000. It did not appear the new law addressed the previous tax. The Commission said they would contact Prosecuting Attorney, Matt Wilson, and ask him to review the August 28, 2018 law.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Carolyn Chrisman to discuss the Enhanced Enterprise Zone. Mrs. Chrisman stated there was a vacancy on the board of the Enterprise Zone due to the retirement of Glenda Hunt. She suggested that Adam Dorrell be a candidate to replace Mrs. Hunt. The Commission was in favor of Mrs. Chrisman's recommendation.

The next meeting of the Enhanced Enterprise Zone will be September 10. Mrs. Chrisman will inform the Enterprise Zone board of the recommendation. She will inform the Commission as to the result of the recommendation that Mr. Dorrell to be added to the Board.



The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on August 22, 2018.


