

# ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES

**MONDAY, AUGUST 27, 2012**  
**11TH DAY JULY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30a.m. on August 27, 2012 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Commissioner Adams moved to accept Ordinance# 2012-13, to be placed on the November 6,

2012 ballot. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion with all in favor. The ballot question will read:

## ADAIR COUNTY USE TAX PROPOSITION

Shall the County of Adair, for the purpose of funding the Road and Bridge Department services, impose a local use tax on out of state purchases at the same rate as the total local sales tax rate, currently 1.000%, provided that if the local sales tax rate is reduced or raised by voter approval, the local use tax rate shall also be reduced or raised by the same action? The purpose of the proposal is to eliminate the current sales tax advantage that Non-Missouri vendors have over Missouri vendors. A use tax return shall not be required to be filed by persons whose purchase from out of state vendors do not in total exceed two thousand dollars in any calendar year.
