At 10:00 a.m., the Commission met with Adair County Collector, Sonja Harden, to discuss credit card options for the Collector's Office. Also present was a representative from KTVO Television. Mrs. Harden had received notification that the credit card company currently serving the Collector's Office would no longer be handling transactions as of July 29, 2015. Several companies were notified to compare interest rates and willingness to participate in the program. She explained the options from several companies. The company that was best suited for the needs of the Collector's Office was a company known as Forte. The interest rate charged by Forte was 2.5% of the amount from all types of transactions and credit card providers. The County would be required to purchase a credit card processing machine which Mrs. Harden stated could be paid for out of the Collector Tax Maintenance Fund as opposed to General Revenue. Per other County Collectors through the State, Forte provides excellent customer service and is easy to work with. There would also be the option of providing on-line payment options for the public at a later date. After discussion, Commissioner Thompson moved to accept Forte as the new credit card provider for the Adair County Collector's Office. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion with all in favor. Mrs. Harden will contact Forte to obtain an agreement which then be signed by Presiding Commissioner Pickens. Mrs. Harden thanked the Commission for their input with a decision.

The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on August 3, 2015.
