

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2020
6TH DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 14, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner King and Commissioner Thompson were present. Presiding Commissioner Shahan was absent.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission participated in a conference call with Tekesha Austin of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to conduct a follow up meeting on #4451-MO Disaster. The incident period of the disaster was April 29, 2019 thru July 5, 2019 when Adair County experienced severe storms and flooding. She has been speaking with Diana Couch from the Adair County Road and Bridge Department. Ms. Austin is waiting on coordinates from Mrs. Couch in order to continue with the project. She wanted to clarify that Diana had the authority to speak with FEMA. Commissioner Thompson stated that was fine, but Mrs. Couch did not have the authority to make decisions for the County.


