BOARD CONFLICT OF INTEREST

POLICY

This conflict of Interest policy is designed to foster public confidence in the Integrity NEMO Workforce Development Beard (the "Organization") and by moted the Organization's interest when it is contampliating entering a transaction (defined below that might benefit the private interest of a clicetor, a corporate officer, the to management or top financial official, a key employee (defined below).

Article II: Definitions

The following are considered insiders for the purposes of this policy:

- Each member of the Board of Directors or other governing body
   (CLEC)
- The president, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, breasurer and chief financial officer, executive director, or any person with the repropulsities of any of those positions.

When that this Conflict of Interns Policy does not assume the existence of a separate Compensation Policy. Compensation read to insiders, including for their service as directors, offices, and key employees, about be evaluated under this Policy in its current form. Article III: Procedures

1. Duty to Disclos

Each interested person shall disclose to the Board all material facts regarding his, her, or its interest (including relevant affiliations) in the transaction. The interested person shall make that disclosure promptly upon learning of the proposed transaction.

Determining Whether a Conflict of Interest Exists

With regard to an interested person, the Board shall determine if a conflict of interest exists.

Procedures for Addressing a Conflict of Interest

The Board shall follow the procedures set forth in Article IV in order to decide what measures are needed to protect the Organization's interests in light of the nature and servicesness of the certificit, to decide whether to enter into the transaction and, if so, to ensure that the terms of the arransaction are appropriate. In the case of an insider who is a director, the director shall not vote on any transaction in which the director has an interest enter the certaining Board members shall decide the matter.

The Board may ask questions of and receive presentation(s) from the insider(s) and any other interested person(s), and may deliberate and vote on the transaction in their presence. The Board shall escentrate that all material facts regarding the transaction and the interested person's conflict of interest have been disclosed to the Board and shall compile appropriate data to ascentrain whether the proposed transaction is total and reasonable to the Organization.

After exercising due diligence, which may include investigating atternatives that present no conflict, the Board shall determine whether the transaction is in the Organization's bost interest, for its own benefit, and whether it is just and reasonable to the Organization; the transaction can be approved by the Board by majority voto of those present at a meeting for which quorum requirements have been met, without counting the vote of any interested directors, interested or common directors without counting the vote of any interested directors, interested or common directors.

#### Article V- Records of Proceedings

The minutes of any meeting of the Board pursuant to this policy shall contain the name of each interested person who disclosed or was otherwise determined to have an interest in a transaction; the nature of the interest and whether it was determined to constitute a conflict of interest; any alternative transactions considered; the members of the Board who were present furing the debats on the transaction, those who voted on it, and to what extent interested persons were excluded from the deliberations; any comparability data or other information obtained and relied upon by the Board and how the information was obtained; and the result of the vote, including, if applicable, the terms of the transaction that was approved and the data it was approved.

### Article VI: Annual Disclosure and Compliance Statement

Each director, each corporate officer, the top management official, the top financial official, and each key employee of the Organization, shall annually sign a statement or the form eta-but that:

- affirms that the person has received a copy of this conflict of interest policy has read and understood the policy, and has agreed to comply with the policy and
- discloses the person's financial interests and family relationships that could

If the Board has reasonable cause to believe that an insider of the Organization has failed to disclose actual or possible conflicts of interest, including those arising from a transaction with a related intorested porson, it shall inform such insider of the basis for this belief and afford the insider an opportunity to explain the alloged failure to disclose, If, after hearing the insider's response and making further investigation as warranted by the circumstances, the Board determines that the insider has failed to disclose an actual or possible conflict of interest, the Board shall take appropriate

#### Article VIII: Annual Reviews

To ensure that the Organization operates in a manner consistent with its status as an organization exempt from federal income sax, the Board shall authorate and oversed an annual review of the administration of this conflict of interest policy. The review may be written or oral. The review shall consider the level of compliance with policy, the confining suitability of the policy, and whether the policy should be
