WEDNESDAY, APRIL 3, 2019
3RD DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 3, 2019 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 8:00 a.m., the Commission participated in the State of the County program held at the Adair County Annex. Entities of the County presented yearly updates of their organizations. These included the Adair County Public Water Supply District #1, Adair County Library, Adair County Health Department, Adair County Sheriff's Department, Adair County Commission, and the Adair County Humane Society.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, reported unofficial results for successful candidates and propositions and questions for the April 2, 2019 Adair County Municipal Election. They are as follows:

Adair County, MO Question for Adair County (Vote for 1): Shall the County of Adair, Missouri impose a monthly fee of \$1.00 on a subscriber of any communications service that has been enabled to contact 911 for the purpose of funding 911 services in the county until October 1, 2023 or until a 911 sales tax is approved by the voters whichever comes first? YES - 1,770 and NO - 1,513;

School Board Directors for LaPlata R-2 School District, (Macon County) Adair County (Vote for 2) were Steven D. McHenry - 44, and Timothy W. Wood - 43;

Proposition K.I.D.S. (Keep Improving District Schools) for R-2 LaPlata School District (Macon County), Adair County (Vote for 1): - Shall the Board of Education for the LaPlata R-II School District, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Three million Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$3,280,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the site development, construction, equipping, and furnishing of a high school cafeteria and elementary gymnasium; to the extent funds are available, complete of other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in a debt service property tax levy of \$0.8000 per hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.0000 to \$0.8000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property. YES - 31 And NO - 22;

Mayor for City of Greentop, Adair County (vote for 1): Charlene Long - 6 with no opposition;

Mayor for City of Novinger, Adair County (Vote for 1) Jeffrey Dodson - 71 with no opposition;

Council Member for City of Kirksville, Adair (Vote for 3) was Zac Burden - 1,051; Jessica Parks - 944, and Chuck Long - 772;

Alderman At-Large for City of Greentop, Adair County (Vote for 2) was Justin Ray - 5 and Kim Veatch -2;

Alderman At-Large for City of Novinger, Adair (Vote for 2) was Janice Pearce - 60 and Rickey Schmidt - 56; Frank Davis (Write-in) -5, and Frank Davis Sr. (Write-in) - 2;

Board of Directors for Adair County Nursing Home, dba Twin Pines Adult Care Center, Adair County (Vote for 2) was Dianthe T. Cable – 2,149 and Elizabeth Clark – 1,885;

Question for Adair County Fire Protection District, Adair County (Vote for 1) Shall there be incorporated the Adair County Fire Protection District consisting of: All of Adair County, Missouri, excluding the following: the City of Kirksville, that portion of the Municipality of Greentop that lies in Adair County, and that portion of the LaPlata Fire Protection District that is in Adair County, with a board of directors consisting of five (5) members, with the authority to impose a levy up to thirty (30) cents per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation on all real and personal property? YES – 400 and NO – 1,131;

Board of Directors for Adair County Fire Protection District, Adair County (Vote for 5) You may vote for five, but not more than five candidates. If a board of five members is elected, the person who received the highest number of votes shall hold office for a term of six years, the persons who received the second and third highest numbers of votes shall hold office for term of four years and the persons who received the fourth and fifth highest numbers of votes shall hold office for terms of two years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Thereafter, members of the board shall be elected to serve terms of six years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified were Patrick Winkleman – 716, Matt Eichor – 702, Mark F. Van Dolah – 675, Curtis Hicks – 648, and Bradley Ray – 642.

The election is scheduled to be certified on Friday, April 5, 2019.

At 2:00 p.m., Adair County Collector, Sonja Harden, presented the Collector's Annual Settlement for the year ending February 28, 2019. The Commission reviewed the settlement and discussion followed. It was noted that \$24,039.22 would be charged off as uncollectable from the 2014 tax year. The settlement will be forwarded to the Missouri Department of Revenue.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on April 3, 2019.


