

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES**  
**TUESDAY, APRIL 30, 2019**  
**14TH DAY APRIL REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 30, 2019 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 9:30 a.m., the Commission met with Aaron Lukefahr from Howe and Co. Mr. Lukefahr wanted to give the Commission an update on the progress of Adair County Bridge 0680007-Project BRO-B001 (50). He presented pictures of the construction site and stated the bridge crew worked on Monday after the rained had stopped. Rain is scheduled for the rest of the week. They will not be able to continue construction until the rain stops and the water goes down.

Mr. Lukefahr said the piling on this bridge should last 100 years and the deck 50-60 years before it needed to be replaced. The project requires that only steel manufactured in the United States be used on the project. Roads leading to the construction site were discussed. Mr. Lukefahr said the project limits for the contactor was 300-400 feet outside of the project. Therefore, any damage to roads that occurred outside that realm would be the responsibility of the County.

Jeff Roberts from Howe Co. is the onsite inspector during the construction. However, Mr. Lukefahr will be on-site occasionally.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
