

ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 7, 2021
3RD DAY APRIL REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on April 7, 2021 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission acted on applications from organizations within Adair County for funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. All applications were previously reviewed by the Northeast Missouri Planning Commission, Adair County CARES Funding Administrator.

Commissioner King moved to approve request # 181 from the Adair County Health Department in the amount of \$1,380.70. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve request # 183 from the Adair County Health Department in the amount of \$10,824.73. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve request # 184 from the Adair County Health Department in the amount of \$9,299.05. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner Thompson moved to approve request # 185 from Adair County Government in the amount of \$111,091.04. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.

The Adair County Commission spent the remainder of the day attending to County business.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on April 7, 2021.
