The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on January 19, 2021 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Commissioner Thompson and Commissioner King were present. Presiding Commissioner Shahan was absent. The Adair County Courthouse was closed on January 18, 2021 in observance of Martin Luther King Day.

The Commission received legal notice from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Waste Management Program they had received a solid waste processing facility construction permit application for A&Z Transfer Station, LLC located at 23390 Clemson Way in Brashear, Adair County, Missouri. Notice will be posted for public viewing at the courthouse until June 6, 2021.

At 1:00 p.m., the Commission met with Howard Carter of Huber & Associates. Mr. Carter wanted to discuss 2021 goals for IT service for Adair County.
