ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES MONDAY, JANUARY 6, 2020 1ST DAY JANUARY REGULAR

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on January 6, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. The Adair County Courthouse was closed on Wednesday January 1, 2020 in observance of New Year's Day.

On January 3, 2020, the Commission signed an order to transfer funds from General Revenue account Temporary Loan to Child Support in the amount of \$10,000.00 to the Child Support Enforcement Fund account Temporary Loan from General Revenue. This amount will allow the Child Support Enforcement Department to meet payroll on January 3, 2020.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission met with Josh Smith, Business Account Sales Executive with U.S. Cellular. Also present at the meeting was Dave Hurt, Finance Coordinator for the Adair County Sheriff's Department, and Rhonda Noe, Adair County Public Administrator.

Mr. Smith is now the contact for the County's phone service. U.S. Cellular currently serves the Sheriff's Department, Public Administrator's office, and the Road and Bridge Department. Mr. Smith discussed current services with Mr. Hurt and Mrs. Noe. He would like to combine all departments of the County with U.S. Cellular services.

The Commission stated that the Road and Bridge Department would no longer need their flip phones as radios are being installed in most of the vehicles. The County Clerk's office currently has service with Verizon but is needing new phones on a limited basis to be used on election days.

After discussion, Mr. Smith will provide costs of phones plus inventory the phones at the Sheriff's Department. He will return with prices for combining cellular services for the entire County that should result in substantial savings. He asked that the Commission provide a hierarchy for authorization changes. He also suggested that quarterly reviews of services be completely on a quarterly basis.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on January 6, 2020.
