The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on January 6, 2021 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission acted on applications from organizations within Adair County for funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

Commissioner King moved to approve an application from K-REDI in the amount of \$15,100.00 (Application 133). Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.



The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on January 6, 2021.


