

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, JULY 14, 2020
6TH DAY JULY REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on July 14, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. Presiding Commissioner Shahan and Commissioner King were present. Commissioner Thompson was absent due to self-quarantine.

At 2:30 p.m., the Commission acted on applications from organizations within Adair County for funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. All applications were previously reviewed by the Northeast Missouri Planning Commission, Adair County CARES Funding Administrator.

Commissioner Thompson had been briefed on the applications and agreed they should be approved by the Commission. An application from a local bank was placed on hold until additional information could be obtained.

Commissioner King moved to approve an application from Teresa's Bridal Boutique, LLC DBA Evey Lynn Bridal in the amount of \$7,041.31 (Application 3). Presiding Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve an application from High Hope Employment Services, Inc. in the amount of \$4,011.66 (Application 4). Presiding Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve four applications from the Adair County Health Department totaling \$66,112,70. These include Application 1 in the amount of \$5,754.30; Application 2 in the amount of \$56,989.65; Application 6 in the amount of \$2,008.03; and Application 7 in the amount of \$1,360.62. Presiding Commissioner Shahan seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion.

Checks for the applicants will be mailed on July 31, 2020.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on July 14, 2020.
