

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JULY 20, 2021  
7TH DAY JULY REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on July 20, 2021, in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission met with Adair County Road and Bridge Supervisor, JB Hamlin, for a six-month review of the Road and Bridge budget. Also present were Adair County Clerk, Sandy Collop, and Deputy Clerk, Tammy Miller.

Income and expenses were discussed for the Road and Bridge Department. Due to additional income and expenses being incurred during 2021, a budget amendment will be required towards the end of the year. The amendment will insure an updated representation of the Road and Bridge Fund at year's end. Overall, the fund is within budget and currently contains a healthy fund balance.


A General Revenue budget review was conducted. The same held true for this fund as well. Due to additional income and expenses being incurred during 2021, a budget amendment will be required towards the end of the year. Many of the changes are COVID 19 related. The amendment will better reflect a more up to date representation of General Revenue at year's end. This fund is also within budget and contains a healthy fund balance.

The Adair County Commissioner adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 20, 2021.


