

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JUNE 29, 2021  
24TH DAY APRIL ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on June 29, 2021, in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met with Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, regarding salaried exempt employees. The Commission decided that these individuals could report "W" as hours worked on their timesheet. The payroll department is to assume that the individual worked at least 35 hours per week which will be reported to CERF for retirement purposes and be eligible for County health insurance. Mrs. Collop stated she would rather have them report hours worked, but the Commission felt reporting a "W" would make the Elected Official of the department accountable for the individual's time worked.



As a result, the Commission decided to go forward with the revised agreement. Commissioner Thompson moved to accept the CTS Agreement as amended on June 28, 2021. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on June 29, 2021.


