

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2019
11TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 5, 2019 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present. Commissioner Thompson was absent in the afternoon to testify during a Senate agricultural hearing in Jefferson City.

The Commission spoke with Adair County Legal Counsel, Ivan Schraeder, in regards to establishing an Emergency Telephone Service 911 Board. Mr. Schraeder had received an e-mail from City of Kirksville Attorney, John Slavin, stating that the County Commission had advised them that the County was required to establish the Emergency Telephone Service 911 Board.

Discussion was held regarding the e-mail and the possibility of serving as the overseer of the emergency telephone service. It was concluded that the County Commission would wait until the April 2, 2019 election to see whether or not the ballot issue was successful. Mr. Schraeder will contact Mr. Slavin to give him an update on the county Commission's decision.

The Commission met with Shannon Howe of Howe Co. to sign paperwork that will be sent to the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) to utilize the BRO program to replace Adair County Bridge No. 3280016 – Project No. BRO-B001(51) and Adair County Bridge No. 2840010 – Project No. BRO-B001(52). He also dropped off information concerning roadway design and construction inspection.

The Commission was unable to survey the storage unit at the Road and Bridge Department. It will be rescheduled.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
