The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 16, 2021 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission met at 2:00 pm with the City of Kirksville. Those present were Presiding Commissioner Mark Shahan, 1<sup>st</sup> District Commissioner Bill King, and 2<sup>nd</sup> District Commissioner Mark Thompson, County Collector Sonja Harden, City Manager Mari Macomber and City Finance Director Lacy King.

Mrs. Macomber wanted to discuss the agreement that the City has with the Collector and the Commission. There were some changes to fees that had been made since the agreement was last updated. Discussion went back and forth as to what the different fees were and why they had been implemented. She wanted to make it clear that when things change that effect the agreement, they need to be made aware of it ahead of time. Mrs. Macomber asked Mrs. Harden about collecting additional fees or assessments for things such as lawnmowing. Mrs. Harden said that the software would not allow it. Mrs. Macomber asked if she was going to be updating anytime soon and was informed that had just been completed.

It was decided to let Mrs. Harden and Mrs. King work between themselves to revamp the agreement and would meet later to finalize it.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on March 16, 2021.
