The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 23, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present, however Presiding Commissioner Shahan arrived later in the morning.

Commissioner King attended an Emergency Operations Committee Meeting early in the day.

At 8:40 a.m., Presiding Commissioner signed additional documents for Adair County Bridge No. 32800162 BRO (51).

At the request of Adair County Sheriff, Robert Hardwick, Commissioner Thompson moved to transfer funds from the Law Enforcement Services account (301-5-001-400.000) in the amount of \$316,600.00 to the Law Enforcement General account (801-4-000-700.200) per letter dated March 20, 2020. Commissioner King seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan was not available at the time of the vote. This amount will hopefully cover salaries and other expenses through the end of 2nd quarter FY 2020.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission conducted a bid opening for an A-133 financial audit for a two-year period ending December 31, 2019. Bids were opened by Presiding Commissioner Mark Shahan and then read aloud. Two bids were received: one from McBride Lock & Associates in the amount of \$18,000 and one from Daniel Jones & Associates in the amount of \$14,500 (all inclusive.

The Commission reviewed the bids. Due to the difference in cost and working favorably with this experienced firm in the past, Commissioner King moved to award the bid to Daniel Jones & Associates. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Both voted in favor of the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan was not available at the time of the vote.

At 2:00 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED that this meeting be continued in closed session, with closed records and closed votes as permitted by law, for consideration of the following items as authorized by section 610.020.4 of the Missouri statutes:

Discussion under Subsection 4 of the statute "When it is necessary to hold a meeting on less than twenty-four hours' notice, or at a place that is not reasonably accessible to the public, or at a time that is not reasonably convenient to the public,......

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any business not covered by the stated reason or reasons for the closed session is raised during the closed session, that such business will be postponed until this meeting is reopened to the public and the sign for a closed meeting is removed from the door. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2020.
