

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 3, 2021
14TH DAY JANUARY ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on March 3, 2021 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission met with Danica Collinge, Administrative Section Chief/Financial Director, for the Adair County Sheriff's Department, to award the bid for prisoner meals. Bids were previously opened on Monday, March 1, 2021.

Mrs. Collinge stated that all bids were reviewed, and it was determined that it would be in the best fiscal interest of the County to award the bid to Tiger Food.

After discussion, Commissioner King moved to award the bid to Tiger Food on the recommendation of the Adair County Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

Contracts for services with Tiger Food will be signed soon.

At 2:00 p.m., the Commission acted on applications from organizations within Adair County for funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

Commissioner Thompson moved to approve an application from the Adair County Ambulance District in the amount of \$38,297.91 (Application #171). Commissioner King seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve an application from the Adair County RII School District in the amount of \$43,333.33 (Application #167). Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.

Commissioner King moved to approve three applications from the Adair County Health Department with a total amount of \$33,346.40. They are Application #178 in the amount of \$1,593.20; Application #179 in the amount of \$8,987.73; and Application #180 in the amount of \$22,765.47. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion.




