At 1:30 p.m., reviewed the E911 tax. 1st District Commissioner Bill King moved to discontinue the Adair County E911 landline telephone tax that was voted on April 4, 2000 at the rate of \$1.45 per landline. 2nd District Commissioner Mark Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Mark Shahan agreed with all in favor.

Providers collecting the E911 tax will be notified via certified mail to discontinue collecting the land line fees upon receipt of the notice.


The Commission spent the rest of the day attending to County business.
