TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2020  
7TH DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 17, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

At 8:00 a.m., Presiding Commissioner Shahan participated in the State of the County. He was one of many representing entities within the County to give an update of their operations. Also participating in the zoom meeting were representatives from the Health Department, Senate Bill 40, Adair County Library, and Adair County Ambulance District.

Commissioner Shahan discussed approving applications for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. He also acknowledged the work of Jim LeBaron of the Adair County Health Department and Sandy Collop of the Adair County Clerk's office in their effort to assist individuals ill with the coronavirus to vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election.

At 1:30 P.M., the Commission opened fuel bids for the Adair County Sheriff's Department. Attending the bid opening along with the Commission was Danica Collinge, Administrative Section Chief/Financial Director for the Sheriff's Department.



The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 17, 2020.


