

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2020
3RD DAY OCTOBER ADJOURNED**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on November 4, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, reported unofficial successful Adair County results for the November 3, 2020 General Election. They were: President and Vice-President of the United States, Donald J. Trump/Michael R. Pence (REP) with 6,391 or 61.83% of the votes; Governor, Mike Parson (REP) with 6,576 or 63.8% of the votes; Lieutenant Governor, Mike Kehoe (REP) with 6,536 or 64.44% of the votes; Secretary of State, John R. (Jay) Ashcroft (REP) with 7,023 or 68.92% of the votes; State Treasurer, Scott Fitzpatrick (REP) with 6,588 or 65.32% of the votes; Attorney General, Eric Schmitt (REP) with 6,603 or 65.35% of the votes; U.S. Rep. 6th District, Sam Graves (REP) with 6,793 or 66.56% of the votes; State Rep. 3rd District, Danny Busick (REP) with 6,500 or 96.96% of the votes; State Rep. 4th District, Greg Sharpe (REP) with 1,910 or 98.86% of the votes; County Commissioner – First District, William “Bill” King (REP) with 4,308 or 96.90% of the votes; County Commissioner – Second District, Mark Thompson (REP) with 3,396 or 71.17% of the votes; Sheriff, Eldon Grissom (REP) with 8,614 or 96.88% of the votes; Assessor, Kent Bryant (REP) with 8,592 or 98.28% of the votes; Public Administrator, Rhonda Noe (REP) with 8,792 or 98.49% of the votes; Coroner, Brian C Noe (REP) with 8,922 or 98.52% of the votes; Surveyor, 563 Write-ins; **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 1** – Do you want to amend the Missouri Constitution to extend the two term restriction that currently applies to the Governor and Treasurer to the Lt. Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor and the Attorney General? State and local government entities estimate no costs or savings from this proposal. – **NO** with 5,365 or 54.33% of the votes; **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 3** – Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to: Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to: Ban gifts from paid lobbyists to legislators and their employees; Reduce legislative campaign contribution limits; Change the redistricting process voters approved in 2018 by: (i) transferring responsibility for drawing state legislative districts from the Nonpartisan State Demographer to Governor-appointed bipartisan commissions; (ii) modifying and reordering the redistricting criteria. State governmental entities expect no cost or savings. Individual local governmental entities expect significant decreased revenues of a total unknown amount. – **YES** with 5,268 or 52.81% of the votes; **JUDICIAL BALLOT – MISSOURI SUPREME COURT JUDGE** - Shall Judge PATRICIA BRECKENRIDGE of the Missouri Supreme Court be retained in office? –**YES** with 6,695 or 74.36% of the votes. Shall Judge TOM CHAPMAN of the Western District Court of Appeals be retained in office? – **YES** with 6,637 or 74.40% of the votes.

Out of 12 precincts reporting, there were 14,915 registered voters in Adair County on Election Day. Total ballots cast were 10,381 which represented a 69.60% voter turnout.

At 10:00 a.m., the Commission along with Adair County Clerk, Sandra Collop, and Human Resource Representative, Heather Kelley met with Mike Deren of Group Benefit Services. Mr. Deren discussed premium rates for 2021 as well as specific diagnoses that will require an increase to individual specific deductibles. Reserves are slowly declining. After discussion, it was decided to maintain the current funding levels of the County’s health care plan. The plan will be re-evaluated during the summer of 2021 to determine if a possible premium change needs to be implemented for the 2022 budget.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on November 4, 2020.
