

**ADAIR COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES  
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2020  
2ND DAY OCTOBER REGULAR**

The Adair County Commission convened at 8:30 a.m. on October 6, 2020 in the Courthouse at Kirksville. All Commissioners were present.

The Commission reviewed a resolution for Adair County, Missouri adopting the Adair County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan and the effort to become a disaster resistance community.

Commissioner King moved to approve Resolution 2020-2 Adair County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. Commissioner Thompson seconded the motion. Presiding Commissioner Shahan concurred. All voted in favor of the motion. The plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Adair County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters.

At 1:30 p.m., the Commission hosted a zoom meeting with Rob Johnson of Huber & Associates to discuss 4<sup>th</sup> 2020 quarter goals for Adair County. Huber & Associates are currently under contract to serve the county with IT support. Also in attendance was Sandra Collop, Adair County Clerk.

Discussion included updating the assessor's server and updating two personal computers from Windows 7; an existing personal computer in the County Clerk's office needs to be evaluated; and the County active directory needs to be updated and any critical machines added to the directory. He stated that in 2022 two of the Assessor's computers as well and one in the Prosecuting Attorney's office, and one in the Public Administrator's office will be four years old. They will need to be updated at that time. Also, data needs to be migrated from the old to the new computer operated by Vicki Robinson's in the Public Administrator's office. The Assessor continues to operate on the old server which needs to be updated so all his information can be moved to the Adair county domain to centralize everyone. Mr. Johnson stressed the importance of contacting their office when an employee leaves the County to disable all programs associated with their employment.

Mr. Johnson will e-mail his presentation to the County Clerk's Office.

The Adair County Commission adjourned at 4:00 p.m. on October 6, 2020.

Adair County, Missouri RESOLUTION NO. 2020-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE ADAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI ADOPTING THE ADAIR COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND THE EFFORT TO BECOME A DISASTER RESISTANCE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS the ADAIR COUNTY recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the ADAIR COUNTY; and

WHEREAS the ADAIR COUNTY has participated in the preparation of a multi-jurisdictional local hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the ADAIR COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, hereafter referred to as the *Plan*, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the *ADAIR COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN* identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in ADAIR COUNTY from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS ADAIR COUNTY recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, the ADAIR COUNTY will endeavor to integrate the *Plan* into the comprehensive planning process; and

WHEREAS adoption by ADAIR COUNTY demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Plan*.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ADAIR COUNTY, in the State of Missouri, THAT:

ADAIR COUNTY HEREBY adopts the ADAIR COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.


