However, any vote on a final decision, when taken by a public governmental body, to hire, fire, promote or discipline an employee of a public governmental body shall be made available with a record of how each member voted to the public within seventy-two hours of the close of the meeting where such action occurs; provided,"

Closed session ended at 12:05 p.m.


At 1:30 p.m., the Adair County Commission adopted the following resolution:

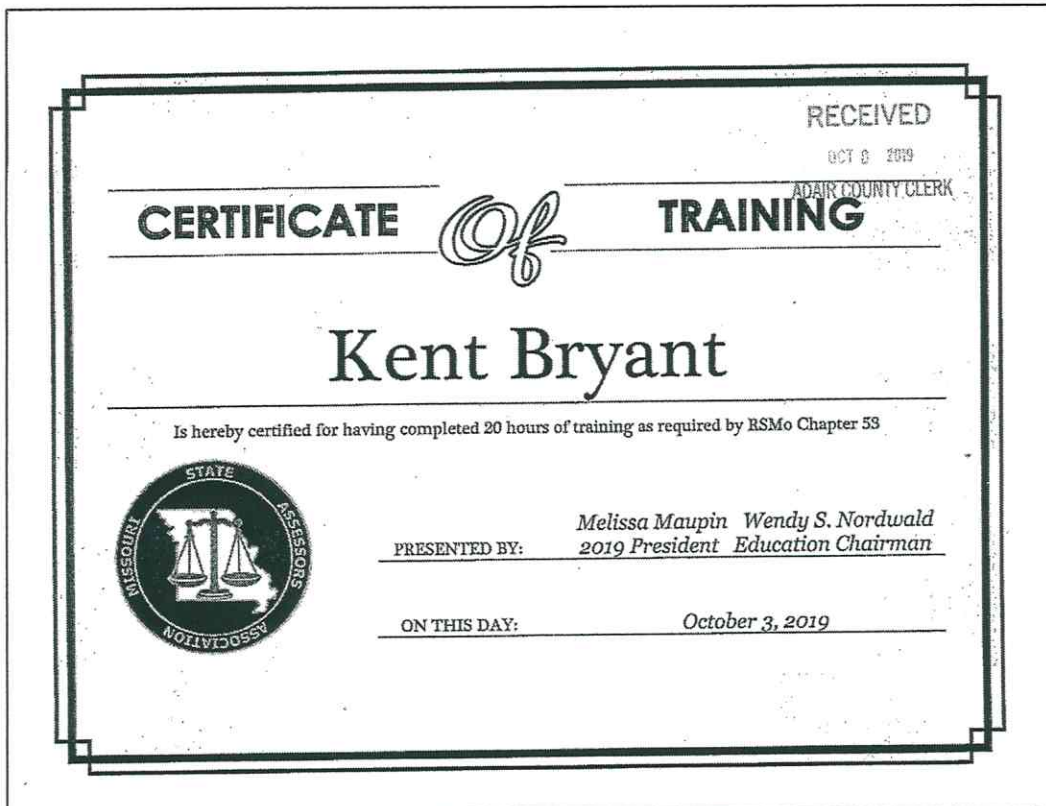
